MISCELLANEOUS PERMIT INFORMATION

ENCROACHMENTS:

Encroachments into the right of way include but are not limited to retaining wall, drain fields, septic tanks, wells, fences, etc.. Encroachment permits must go before the board of road commissioners for approval. The permit fee is \$50.00.

BORING FOR UTILITIES:

When installing or repairing buried cables all crossings under paved county roads must be directional bored at a minimum depth of 48".

OPEN TRENCHING:

Open trenching is permitted on gravel roads. A minimum depth of 48" is required in conjunction with proper signing and channelizing devices to direct traffic around the work area..
