Dead Animal Policy

Policy

The purpose of this policy is to establish a procedure for the removal of dead animals that pose a safety hazard within the traveled portion of a state or county maintained road in order to minimize Road Commission costs while still maintaining safety. The traveled portion of the road shall include the road shoulder. Any dead animals that are a safety hazard will be removed by dragging them off the traveled portion of the road. In highly populated areas, they will be removed by dragging them down the road or hauling them to a remote location. In no case will the Road Commission be responsible for dead animals placed in the traveled portion of the road by adjacent property owners.

Rule

Administration of this policy will be at the discretion of the Superintendent or Road Foreman.
